Not many restaurants make it 100 years. Manchester, New Hampshire's Red Arrow Diner has kept the comfort in comfort food while staying true to many original favorites. What will surprise even the old timers, are the many stories tied to unexpected people and organizations. There is an early Rockefeller connection while to-day's fans include local guy Adam Sandler, a Red Arrow regular. Also spotted, celebs from Kevin Costner to RuPaul to Barenaked Ladies. And of course, nearly every presidential hopeful for the past 40 years has slurped Red Arrow chili and even a couple lucky candidates have been de-virginized in a diner ritual that locals love. Quirky and adorable, the Red Arrow is the heartbeat of downtown Manchester.



Mike enjoyed 53 years (1971-2024) as a radio personality in Washington, D.C., New York City, Boston and New Hampshire, locally on WZID-FM from 1994-2014.

His writing career began in 2004, where after 21 years, Mike produces a humor column every other Sunday for the *Nashua Telegraph*. He is a current contributor to *New Hampshire Magazine* and has had articles in the *Boston Globe* and *Chicken Soup for the Soul* books. His TV credits include work as a television weatherman and nine-years co-hosting nearly 300 candlepin bowling TV shows. Mike's first book, a career memoir, *Fifty Shades of Radio: True Stories of a* 

Morning Radio Guy Being Wired, Tired and Fired, came out in 2013. In 2019, he released Lunch with Tommy and Stasia: TV's Golden Age of Candlepin Bowling. In late 2022, he released his newest book, If These Walls Could Talk, on the history of New Hampshire's Red Arrow Diner, which turned 100 in October. He was a recipient of the Will Rogers Humanitarian Award in 2013 from the National Society of Newspaper Columnists. Mike lives in Nashua with Barbara Baker and their Westie dog, Portia Rose.




